Citizens are invited to attend a Public Meeting and encouraged to provide comments concerning the operation of the Emanuel Tire Processing Facility located at 3476 Atlantic Lane, Waverly, Virginia 23890 (within the Atlantic Waste Disposal landfill facility). The purpose of this notice is to acquaint the public with the technical aspects of the tire processing facility and the applicable regulatory standards and requirements, to identify any issues of concern, and to facilitate communications between Emanuel Tire and those that are affected by the facility.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of application for a Virginia Department of Environmental Quality permit for a material recovery facility as described under 9VAC20-81-410.A. This facility recovers tires, inner tubes and steel rims for reuse or recycling in various industries and has been in operation.
